Depending on the foreign employee's country of citizenship or nationality, there may be a delay before the Foreign Employee can apply for a permanent residence ('green card"). In those situations, TTUHSC will continue to extend the current work visa status to ensure uninterrupted employment. Employees so affected should regularly review the Department of State's monthly Visa Bulletin to determine when they can file the I-485 application(s). ➤ The Department is not required to pay the legal or filing fees related to the Foreign Employee's personal portion (i.e. I-485 application) of the "green card" process. However, if the department chooses to do so, they may. I-485 fees are not business expenses, and are considered income to the Employee. Therefore, there are tax consequences to the Employee if the Department pays the I-485 fees.
