#### Services Provided

- Pet food and veterinary care assistance
- Books on wheels
- Flowers every Friday
- Resources for other needs (eligibility specialist is also a social worker)
- Senior secret Santa during Christmas
- Mardi Gras event

- Meals on Wheels accommodates for people with diabetes and other dietary restrictions.
- Monthly menu approved by a dietitian.

- Meals on Wheels is a resource available for patients that qualify.
- Be informed of all the services that Meals on Wheels have to offer.
- Meals on Wheels can cater the patient's meals according to their health needs
- Patients that qualify for this agency are usually wheelchair bound or elderly and are not physically able to shop for groceries or leave their house on their own.
- No payment required (not based on income, Medicare/Medicaid)
- Ability for flexibility in qualifications based on funding (solely donation)
- It is a non-profit organization, and its delivery drivers are all volunteers
