Population Served

Patients receiving cancer treatment who live greater than 40 miles from Lubbock

Largely small town residents from West Texas and Eastern New Mexico

Services Provided

Patients receive a nurturing community to help them with their cancer treatment, while in Lubbock

Provides a supportive community, where guests can enjoy their meals and unwind from their stress

Average stay is 10 nights (ranging from 1 night to 2 months)

Rooms allow for caregiver to stay with the patient

Clients' Health Needs

Provides a safe and clean environment for cancer patients to stay

Relieves the financial stress placed on families during treatment

Allows the patient to relax and focus on overcoming their battle with cancer

Currently closed due to Covid-19, but healthcare workers can use the facilities to avoid bringing Covid to their household

Clients' Health Information Needs

Provide information to families and patients that assists with understanding the diagnosis

Resources to find support programs or services in the area

Provide information about coping with financial or insurance issues

Advice for Physicians

Be able to recognize situations where patients may have hardship in finding local accommodations

Be aware of patients who may require services, as staying with the Hope Lodge requires a referral from the cancer treatment center

Ensure that patients have knowledge of the local and long-term resources available to them

Volunteers are always welcome to assist with facility care and improve patient experience during stay
