Guidelines for Arriving Students in the Graduate Program in Pharmaceutical Sciences

- 1. Incoming students <u>must</u> report to the Graduate Program Coordinator on their designated campus by the First Day of Orientation. Exception can be made in the case of a major issue such as a medical or administrative issue. In all cases, students must be enrolled and in attendance for the "12th Class Day" at the latest as set by the TTUHSC Jerry H. Hodge School of Pharmacy.
- 2. Incoming students are required to attend <u>all</u> sessions of Graduate Student Orientation. Students arriving in the Spring or Summer must attend the following Fall Orientation sessions.
- 3. All students must register for at least 9 credit hours of graduate study no later than the published "12th Class Day" as set by the TTUHSC Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences. Failure to register for the required hours by the "12th Class Day" will result in termination from the Graduate Program in Pharmaceutical Sciences.
- 4. All payments, or arrangement for payment of tuition and fees must be made by the published "Last date to make Payment" as set by the TTUHSC Student Business Services. Failure to make payment or arrangement for payment by this date will result in termination from the Graduate Program in Pharmaceutical Sciences.
