Guidelines for Distribution of Graduate Students and Graduate Student Research Assistantships in the Graduate Program in Pharmaceutical Sciences. This guideline applies only to PhD students.

- 1. Graduate Students (PhD students) will be approved for admission to the Graduate Program in Pharmaceutical Sciences (GPPS) by the GPC and admitted with the expectation (as outlined in the admission letter) that they will receive financial support for graduate research as long as they are enrolled into the program.
- 2. At the time a student chooses a laboratory, a funding plan will be submitted to GSBS.
- **3.** GPPS graduate faculty members can have, at any given time, at least 2 fully state-funded (4-year funding) students, pending approval from the Department Chair.
- **4.** Provided that an applicant meets the criteria for admission to the GSBS and is approved for admission by the GPPS Graduate Program Committee, students may be recruited, admitted and targeted to selected laboratories providing the faculty member is willing to pay the Research Assistantship for the entire pursuit of a graduate degree.
