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### **National Cancer Institute Central IRB**

National Cancer Institute Central IRBs will serve as the IRB of record for Phase III-IV co-operative group, multi-site clinical trials where TTUHSC faculty serve as the local Principal Investigator.

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### **IRB Master Reciprocity Agreement for Texas Institutions of Higher Education**

Multi-site research conducted at Texas academic institutions that have agreed to participate in the Master Reciprocity Agreement may be able to rely on a single IRB for review of the research.

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
