

Texas Tech Health Sciences Center Student Senate Resolution Annual 10% Fee Cap

WHEREAS, the Student Service Fee is mandated by the Texas State Legislature not to be increased by more than 10% annually without a student referendum,

WHEREAS, past Texas Tech System student fees have increased over 10% without any student input,

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any and all fees that come from the students of the Texas Tech System should not be increased by more than 10% annually, beginning with the proposed fees for the 2003-2004 academic year, unless brought to a student referendum.
