## TEXAS TECH UNIVERSITY HEALTH SCIENCES CENTER

Senate Resolution 23.02

(Stating the sentiments of the TTUHSC Student Senate regarding the proposal to increase the minimum number of students needed to utilize TTUHSC Lubbock campus Pod D glass study rooms.)

WHEREAS, The West expansion ("Pod D") has served as an innovative building; and,

WHEREAS, the building includes the gross anatomy lab, several classrooms, administrative offices, but contains a limited number of study rooms on the 5th floor Pod D; and,

WHEREAS, on the top (5th) floor, the big glass study rooms serve as a popular site for students; and,

WHEREAS, there are limited large study rooms in general at the HSC, and these big glass study rooms are conducive for collaborative work, which is a mission of the HSC; and

WHEREAS, students from all TTUHSC programs have been able to use the study rooms, which are built to fit up to 5 or 6 students at a time, yet individual students take up the large rooms; and therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Student Senate of Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center propose that the TTUHSC Lubbock campus Pod D 5th floor large glass study rooms be utilized by a group of two or more students; and therefore,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution be forwarded and sent to Lori Rice-Spearman, Ph.D., President of Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center; Darrin D'Agostino, D.O., M.P.H., Provost and Chief Academic Officer; Arianna Flores, Editor-in-Chief of *The Daily Toreador*; and to the students of Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center.
