Dr. Selim Krim is a board-certified internist. He joined TTUHSC Lubbock in July 2007 as an Assistant Professor of Medicine in the Division of General Internal Medicine. He obtained his Doctor of Medicine degree from the University of Algiers, Algeria in 2001 and completed his internal medicine residency training at the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center, McKeesport in 2007.

As clinician and educator, Dr. Krim supervises residents and medical students in patient care and conducts educational activities including bedside and didactic teaching. He also serves as the Associate Director of the MSIII Continuity Clinic. His research focuses on coronary artery disease in the elderly and the impact of cardiometabolic risk factors on heart failure in the Hispanic population. He actively participates in quality improvement initiatives by acting as a University Medical Center physician champion for heart failure core measures.
