Responsibility

- 1) Be concerned for the well-being of your patient.
- 2) Proactively help patients achieve maximum benefit from their medications and commit to their welfare.
- 3) Demonstrate active listening and appropriate nonverbal communication skills.
- 4) Proactively pursue evidence to improve patient care and professional practice.
- 5) Recognize authority and work within the organizational structure.
- 6) Keep commitments and appointments.
- 7) Complete assignments in a timely manner.
- 8) Give timely requests for excused absences or special accommodations.
- 9) Follow practice-site-specific policies and procedures.
- 10) Meet deadlines for provision of documentation of immunization status, TB testing, etc.
- 11) Provide leadership (formal and informal) in the profession, community, and healthcare teams to improve pharmacists' role in optimizing medication use.
